



How to become a Communication Vendor for the Black Child Legacy Campaign

The Steps listed below will guide you in the process of applying to become a communication vendor for the Black Child Legacy Campaign. All communication vendors must be selected from an approved vendor list on the Black Child Legacy Campaign website.

Step One:

Download and fill out the Black Child Legacy Campaign Communication Vendor Application

Step Two:

Return the completed form to raacd@shfcenter.org with "BCLC Communications Vendor" in the subject line.

Step Three:

Once approved, you will be placed on the Black Child Legacy Campaign Vendor List on our website at www.blackchildlegacy.org.

Step Four:

Monitor the Black Child Legacy Campaign website for open contract opportunities and follow instructions for submitting a contract bid. Vendors on the approved vendor list may also be contacted directly with opportunities.

Please note: All vendors listed on the approved vendor list will still be required to submit a scope of work and sign a contract to complete work with The Center. Being listed on the approved vendor list does not guarantee contracted work.
